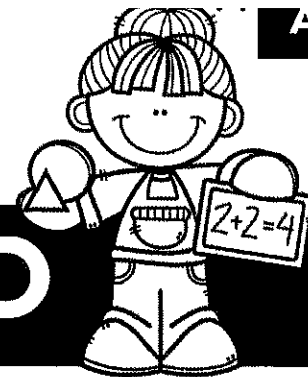

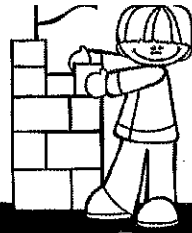

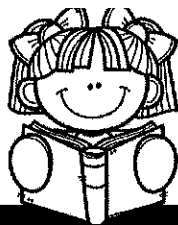
MORE FUN CHOICE BOARD

Learn how to cook scrambled eggs.	Go outside and practice playing soccer.	Play "I Spy..."	Make pizza at home!


